



# Bomb Threat Management Planning (MGT-451)

The **Bomb Threat Management (BTM) Planning** course provides participants foundational knowledge on the DHS risk management process and bomb threat management planning. It gives participants the opportunity to apply this knowledge to develop a bomb threat management plan.



## Course Format and Audience

This is a one-day, in-person instructor led training covering the following topics:

- DHS risk management process
- BTM plan roles and responsibilities
- BTM plan components and development
- Capstone activity: drafting a BTM plan

This course is designed for groups of up to 25 participants and is intended for audiences such as:

- Critical infrastructure owners and operators
- Public safety officers
- Emergency managers
- Security officers
- Law enforcement officials
- Private sector security professionals
